


Figure 1. Drip Guard Folded

ABOUT THE DRIP GUARD

This kit consists of a plastic drip guard and is designed for use in split system heat pump products. The kit is intended to prevent condensate from dripping onto the control board.

DRIP GUARD INSTALLATION

Read these installation instructions completely before proceeding. Refer to the manufacturer's instructions for more installation information.

- 1. Disconnect all power to the unit.
- 2. Remove access panel from unit to expose the electrical components for the condenser.
- Prepare the drip guard for installation by folding along the score marks to form the shape shown in figure 1.
 NOTE: The plastic drip guard is packaged in the kit flat and must be folded before installation.




Figure 2. Drip Guard Installed

- 4. Install the drip guard end that has holes behind the defrost board. Press the standoffs through the holes in the drip guard. See Figure 2.
- 5. Push the standoffs through the electrical panel to secure the defrost board and drip guard to the unit.
- 6. Install the access panel and apply power to the unit.
